Trainers who attend will receive all of the tools, information, and materials that they need to conduct this valuable safety training for their companies' employees. Registration fee: \$395 through February 6 and \$495 after that date.

March 10-11: CNG Fuel System Inspector Training

Formerly called the NGV Fuel Storage Cylinder Inspection Training, this two-day course focuses on teaching the proper techniques for inspecting on-board compressed natural gas fueling systems. NHTSA states that on-board vehicle CNG fuel storage cylinders, manufactured after March of 1995, should be visually inspected every three years or 36,000 miles, whichever comes first. You will learn the proper methods to use to insure vehicle fuel storage safety and integrity. The training includes hands-on inspection of vehicle fuel cylinders. Registration fee: \$695 through February 6 and \$795 after that date. At the end of this course, you may choose to take the CSA Certification exam for a fee of \$375.

The training will be held from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. each day on the University of Nevada, Las Vegas campus, located at 4505 South Maryland Parkway in Las Vegas, Nevada. The meeting room is 211 in the Moyer Student Union.
